

# How to use the Integrated Tariff in AW.

After logging into Asycuda World, you are taken to the home screen which part of it is shown on the left below:




Figure 1: A part of the main AW window

The “**Document library**” should be automatically opened, if not click the icon  to open it. Then go to **ASYCUDA** → **Integrated Tariff** → **Commodity Codes** → **National Tariff** then right click **National tariff** and select “**View**”.

The above steps will take you to the “**National Tariff**” window and by default this window always comes up blank when it is opened.

There are two ways to find a tariff code in this window:

1. **The finder/ search option** – Click the finder icon,  it will display a list of **chapters** then click your desired chapter to get to your **headings** then click the heading to get to the **sub**

headings then HS Code ( 6 digit) and from there you can read the HS description do your selection on the eighth level.




Figure 3: Option one finder option

2. **The keyword search option** – type your key word on the “**Keyword – Commodity Code**” text and click the **search** button and they search will highlight all the occurrences of the word. You can always click the heading to narrow your search and continue till you reach the HS Code




Figure 4: Option two Keyword search

The Tariff view window has a few important parts and these are outlines briefly below:




Figure 5: National Tariff - View window

1. **Description window** -- displays the different level of the Harmonized system that you have gone down. It also displays the descriptions at each level.
2. **Left Selection Window** – The interactive window where a user can click the any code to have access to.
3. **Right selection window** – displays the application date of each code, and the description also. The orange arrow  when clicked, it takes you to the “**View Histo Content**” as show below:

4. **The tariff calculator or tariff simulation**  – only comes out when you are at the 11<sup>th</sup> digit level. It gives you the opportunity to enter the details of your declaration and then by clicking the **calculator icon**, it calculates the proposed duties and taxes payable if SAD is processed. This simulation is shown below:

5. **Tariff Rates tab** – This is a side tab in the **Tariff simulation** window discussed above. It shows the rates of a particular commodity code if you click the **red tick**.  As shown below:
